Ammunition count and additional information for events.

Lever action match:

Open category match 40 rounds needed, and scores will be put in for the state postal match.

Combined Services Discipline Core pistol:

Event open to class 1 and 2 pistols 36 rounds needed for each class.

Field rifle match:

Field Rifle Rimfire 42 rounds. Field Rifle Centrefire 42 rounds.

Spectrum 22:

.22 event with an expected total of 60 rounds needed. Advise bringing 100 rounds or two boxes to allow for practice and any shoot off's etc.

Shotgun 5 stand:

50 target event will need extra for second shots 70-80 expected in total.

IRB Benchrest:

Match 50 rounds needed plus as many sighters as you wish, typically 100rds in total.

Silhouette rimfire:

40 rounds main match, plus any extras needed for shoot off's, practice etc.

Single Action:

4 stages with a total of 40 pistol, 40 rifle and 16+ shotgun. Allow extra for re-shoots etc.

ICORE Match:

4 stages with a total of 80 rounds needed once again allow extra for re-shoots etc.

Trap shotgun:

50 target double barrel match allow 70-80 shells.
